#### 2.1 Client Information

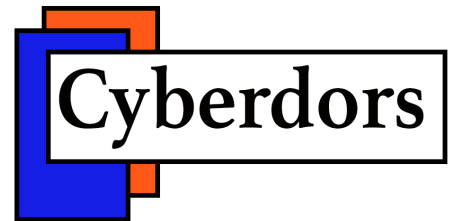
Information provided directly by clients, including:

We use collected information to:

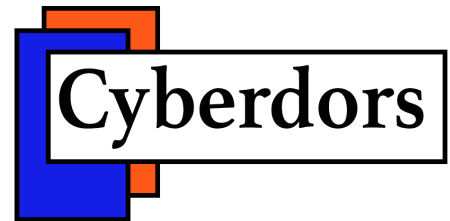
- Deliver cybersecurity advisory and managed services

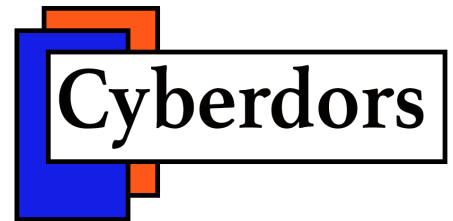
